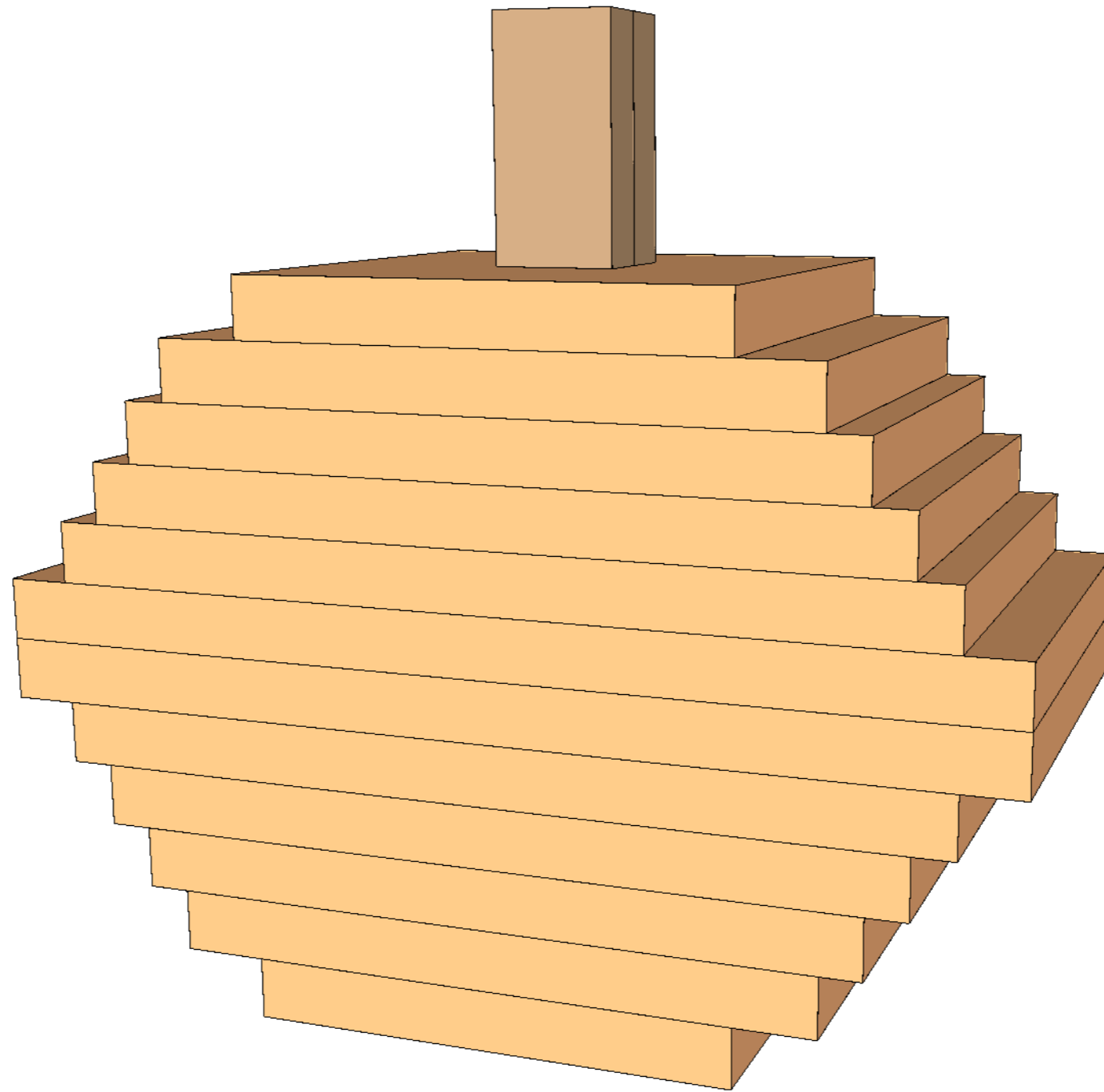


Pumpkin Decorations

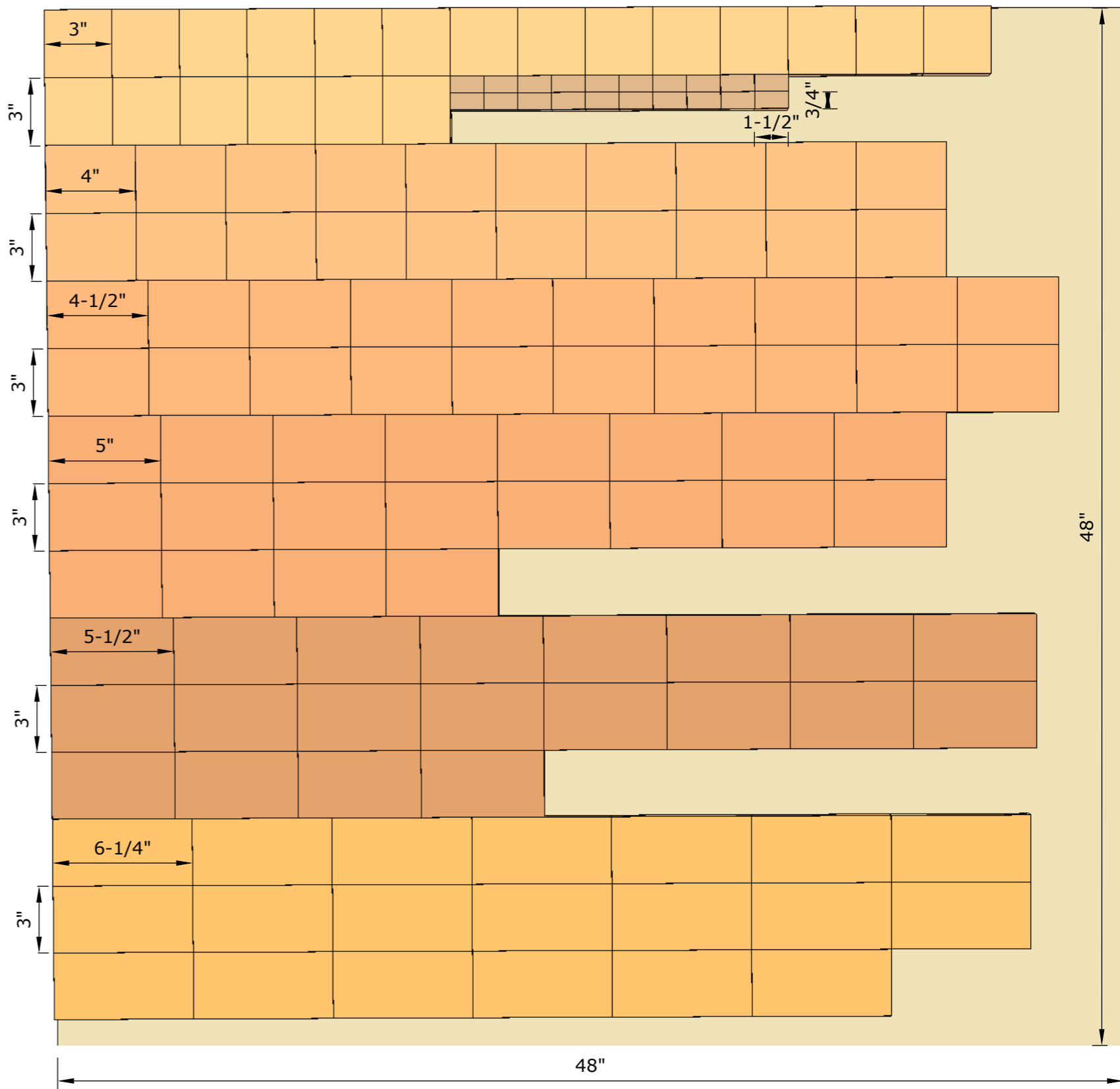
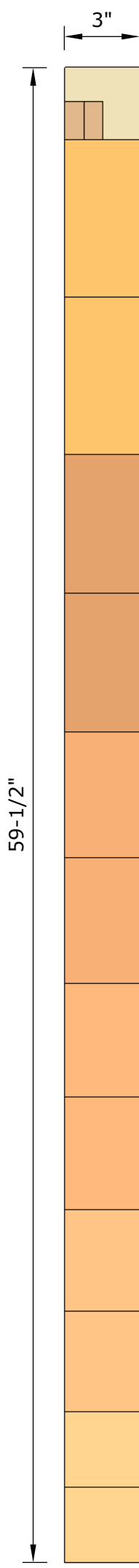


Cut List

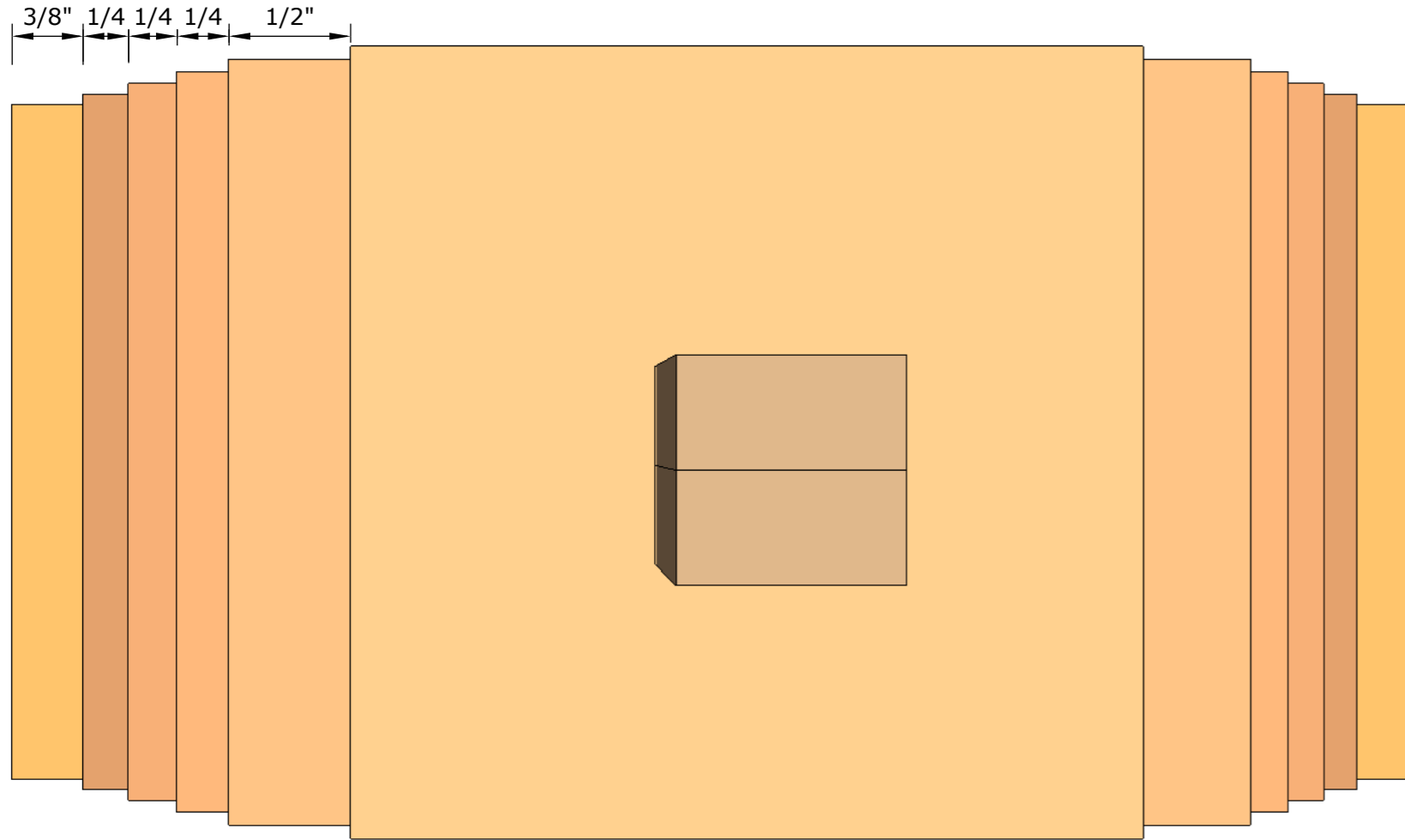
This is a great scrap wood project! It takes a board that is 5' x 3" to make one pumpkin.

However, if you want to make a few to either give away or have in a few places around the house, then I suggest purchasing a 4' x 4' sheet of 3/8" plywood. You will be able to get 10 pumpkins from one sheet.

Tip: To make things easier, have the employee at the home store cut the board into 3" strips for you, so all you have to do is cut the pieces to length.

Glue everything together then set something heavy on top of it for about an hour. Once the glue is dry, sand off the squeeze out and any rough edges then give your pumpkin a coat of paint.
